OLD BIZ:

We had asked an addict to find out how much it would cost us to make the area service MTG hybrid. Below is the information they provided us.

Our Service body qualifies as a large conference meeting. The goal would be to bring roughly 30 people together (in person & virtually) without any echoes, loop, & to provide the same environment/equal atmosphere that happens when all members are in person or controlling their own virtual settings.

Messiah Lutheran is not equipped for this so we would have to start from scratch. Here is the estimate we received when I reached out:

2 laptops = @ \$219.00 each x's 2 = \$428.00 1 projector = \$224.00 1 screen = \$100.00 Microphone system= \$200.00 8 channel mixer= \$79.00 Cords, cables, USB sound interface card =\$150.00 Webcam= \$60.00 Internet= \$40 a month Total: \$1,291.00

If we moved forward with this it was explained to me that we would need members who are willing to learn this equipment & software. The process would take several meetings & a lot of grace to get the hang of it. The 2nd possible alternative is to move to a different location. We could try to find a facility that is set up with this equipment. For example a bigger church or a hotel conference room. If we went that route it would greatly cut our budget down significantly, however, we would have to hope the facility would allow us to have access to it & would be willing to train one of our members on how to use the equipment.

Our subcommittees have been functioning extremely well through the pandemic & virtually! Our Unity Subcommittee has been kicking ass this year! The job of the area service body is to come together & combine resources because: H&I, Unity, Phone lines, Literature, Policy, Meeting List is way too much for 1 singular group to handle! When is the last time this area did a CAR report or a workshop? Outside of Unity & H&I we have done nothing! Let's actually do something that will affect people! The Infectious recovery groups have been VERY GOOD to us! Their GSR has not missed an ASM in 18 months! Infectious Recovery carried this area & donated when NO other groups did! We discussed when Infectious recovery asked to join the area that they are 4 virtual home groups that DO NOT meet physically. They are carrying the message, recovering, & stay clean ALL OVER THE WORLD! THIS IS A GOOD THING! How are we going to move backwards instead of forwards & give them the boot from our area? Maybe further on down the line the Infectious recovery groups will fold...maybe they won't...BUT THEY haven't yet! We don't NEED to meet in person. This is an accessibility issue. Now that some groups are reopening physically.. Members have opinions! A member shared that it was hard to concentrate virtually when you could hear dogs barking in the background. We discussed that we need to take into account the new variant that is out & killing people. Living this new way of life we should really move forward with this decision responsibly. Some members felt we should move the ASM to the Malvern center because it has virtual/hybrid MTGS 7 days a week. Some members shared that hybrid is very expensive & has a lot of issues & that maybe we should only be discussing/ arguing over meeting physically or in person & take hybrid out of the equation. It was suggested that maybe some members could start a new home group on Sundays at 7pm & call it Area. That way the "area group" could hold its meetings in person & everyone can show up, hug it out, & stroke each other's egos! It was stated again that all this "bitchin" is nothing but "ego masturbation!" Groups aren't going to get involved just because we are meeting physically, they don't care! It was suggested that we throw the personalities out the door & focus on the principals...all bullshit aside we need as many members as we can to become involved in service! A member shared that she is trying to take her time & weigh out decisions today. Area was a safe place for her to come to, network, meet people, & broaden her base when she was new in recovery. Not everything we do here is bullshit & ego boosting. Not wanting to hear the dogs bark.....isnt a good reason to want to change how we are meeting. There are

currently a lot of things to weight out when it comes to this decision. We ended the discussion with the fact that there is a motion on the floor & it should go back to the groups. We will vote at the Sept ASM & currently there is nothing in the policy about the whole situation.
