Nominations: None.....H&I Co-Chair position is open.

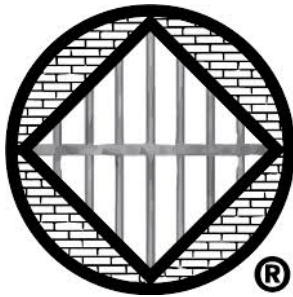

- Right now Adam S is printing out meeting list... driving them around to all the Home groups that need them, dropping them off upon request The Area is reimbursing him for the printing costs about \$20.00 every other month.. There is a cheaper, simpler, more sufficient method that we have been using in area, & regional H&I It costs us pennies, It takes the addict to the most up to date meeting info, & it is a convenient size!! Below is a copy of what we have been using, on the back there is a phone list area. What we have done is purchased a case of card stock for \$20.00 & ink to refill the cartridges for \$13.99 We are able to print out four 4X6 Meeting Cards on one sheet of card stock & it takes us just minutes to do it! When the groups need to get literature from Kyle they could pick up a stack of these cards for their home group. If any of the meeting information changes it won’t matter because the information on the cards NEVER changes...it takes the addict to the most up to date information that is updated daily. They have been flying like hot cakes in H&I presentations & we haven’t even gone through ¼ of the ink or the paper yet & we have printed out & distributed hundreds of copies! **PLEASE REVIEW** this with your homegroup so your GSR can bring back feedback at Decembers area service body meeting!

A member shared that we have a responsibility to fill our trusted servant responsibilities & if things do happen to come up we should be transparent with the GSR's. Region is 6 times a year & we have had no representation with our RCM's the past 3 regions. We are missing out on a lot of information & changes that are going on right now in our fellowship. Our regional IT special worker & IT subcommittee have created a really cool regional meeting search dial in program! Its called the YAP. (There was a demonstration of this sent out in the email with the regional minutes) The purpose of the YAP is to dial a # & have options to speak with someone from the helpline, or request that the local & closest meeting information be texted to your phone right from the BMLT. This is a really cool tool & is ready to launch right now! The CAR report just came out & there was a duplicate entry that was sent out in the SPAD approval draft (Correct entry was emailed our earlier in the month). If we don't have representation at region the information stops at area & does not flow both ways through our service structure.

- A member was disappointed that the phone line orientation days have not been relayed to the members in our area. The policy Chair said she will get information about this as there are more upcoming phone line orientation days in the near future for members who wish to get in service.

-There was much discussion about the current nomination on the floor for an area convention rep. currently there is no GPRNA convention committee & the region is currently discussing how to disburse the funds. The discussion was do we need to elect a convention rep when there is no regional convention committee for our member to serve on. A Member shared that there are other open positions right now in Clean Acres that need filled before we serve the region.

- A member shared that our area has not done a CAR in a while & now that we have the current CAR out it would be nice to invite the RD team out & host a CAR workshop as an area so groups can work through the current CAR. There was positive discussion about this & the GSR consensus was to have the RCM's reach out the RD team & set up a date for a workshop.

- A member shared that there HG has a discussion about how many terms a trusted servant can serve consecutively. There group believes in serving in the spirit of rotation & wanted to bring attention to the fact that hasn't exactly been happening in our area. The group is going to discuss it more & possibly bring a motion to the floor next month.
