<u>ADMIN REPORT:</u> - Received a phone call from Donna at Gaudenzia DRC requesting H&I bring in a presentation 2 days a week for the outpatient clinic. I informed her that H&I services are for Addicts who can't leave the facility to attend regularly scheduled NA meetings. I referred her to our website <u>www.naworks.org</u> for a listing of nearby meetings close to the facility that the outpatients could attend. She informed me that they are attending 3 local meetings a week & inquired about the possibility of starting an NA meeting in house at their facility. I connected her with Public relations chair Brother James for further details & information.

- About 4 years ago the Delco area attended region & said that the facility, Recovery Centers of America, (Devon, PA) was requesting an additional presentation for a second night every week. Delco did not have enough support in their area so they asked other areas for support. Clean Acres stepped up to temporarily cover the second night & 4 years later they are still fulfilling the commitment which is over an 1 hour away from most of the members in that area. Clean Acres is asking that Delco take back that commitment if they can. If not, Clean Acres will be dropping that meeting. Contacted Delco H&I Chair Joe & he will bring it to the subcommittee's attention at their April meeting. More info to follow later.

- Our basic Texts from the East Coast convention have come in! (YAY!!) I will be meeting the RD later this week to pick up the 3 cases we were given this year! If your area currently has a prison or DRC commitment OR is currently sending literature into those institutions please make a note of it when you email me your minutes so I can provided those areas with the Basic Texts first!
