NEW BUSSINESS: -Reached out to the prison, we have a new point of contact counselor Williams. He reported that sense our H&I presence has not been at the facility they are noticing a lot of offenders coming back in & out & they cant help but wonder if they were exposed to NA through H&I would it maybe be different for them? He said that he has been pushing for us to resume physical meetings...however the prison still has an exposure to covid concern. We suggested possibly have our members provide proof of vaccination & unfortunately at this time we are not able to resume physical or virtual presentations. He did say that the facility has tons of AA literature & that offenders are constantly requesting NA literature & mail correspondence. H&I moved swiftly! We used rubber bands to make 40 newcomers packet containing all the suggested H&I IP'S, 4x6 meeting cards, our p.o box address, & 8 Basic texts! Regional PR donated 6 Posters with bi-lingual information about how to find NA if you need help with a drug problem upon release (these will be posted in each cell block) Regional H&I donated 10 more English Basic Texts & 3 Spanish Basic Text. All of this was dropped off at the prison this past Friday with counselor Williams & will be distributed to inmates upon request.

- -Last month Ricky our Monday night Malvern panel leader brought to the subcommittee information about an alumni coordinator trying to replace our Monday evening H&I presentation with an alumni recovery meeting. We contacted the facility & Malvern is extremely happy & grateful with all the NA service the Clean Acres members have provided, unfortunately, they do have to fit this alumni meeting into their weekly schedule. So we will be at Malvern every Monday & Wednesday until the 1St week in August then we will only be in there on Wednesdays. We don't want to lose any trusted servants so BethAnn will reach out to Ricky about splitting the commitment.

OLD BIZ:

*** PR would like to make a motion to get \$650 from the Area to being printing 100 mugs with the intent to raise money for literature donations to local prisons. ***

GSR'S VOTED THIS MOTION DID NOT PASS

-There was a lot of discussion around the ADHOC committee. Our groups did pass a motion to put together a ADHOC committee with the goal of bringing back & presenting information to the groups to see if a hybird area would be possible to obtain. As members logged into the area service meeting the ADHOC committee members were currently located physically at Messiah Lutheran with equipment set up & running. It was discussed that it was great to see the ADHOC committee excited about the task at hand! However the motion passed was to form a committee to find

out information. The groups were not notified that the committee had been formed & when & where the first meeting would be held so that members in our area could get involved in the ADHOC committee. There was discussion around our fellowship being fully self-supporting & our 7th tradition. If equipment is needed to be purchased for hybrid capabilities a budget should be presented to the area, rather than having individual members purchase equipment. There was discussion that the ADHOC committee is like any other subcommittee & should meet prior to our area service meeting at 5:30pm & provide the groups with a report each month & receive guidance as the other subcommittees do. We discussed if the ADHOC committee is going to be meeting a Messiah & using the internet that we need to pay for the use of the facility & the internet. The Treasurer said he would look over what we were paying Messiah previously and add on 1/4 of the cost to cover internet access & let us know next month. The ADHOC committee members stated that all the feedback & discussion was great, in their haste they did not hold a meeting & put information out to the fellowship, but that we do need to go back because the policy states we meet at Messiah Lutheran. Also if anyone wants to be a part of the ADHOC committee everyone has all of their phone numbers & could have called them.
