

<u>ADMIN REPORT:</u> --SKVA H&I is back up & running! Spoke with SKVA H&I Chair Kim, said that they have members who are willing to serve & the area is ready to take back the Charter Fairmount Commitment on Tuesday at 8pm, 1 meeting for women & 1 meeting for men! We will need to schedule a presentation with the facility Montco H&I, & SKVA so that the transfer is smooth. Until date is set, asking that Montco continue the commitment. - Received a call from A Camden member & an inquiry from regional PR about facilities in the Camden Area requesting H&I presentations. Camden does not have H&I, PR, unity subcommittees functioning right now. It was discussed if we should still schedule initial presentations with the facility knowing that we DO NOT have the people or service efforts to fulfill commitments. WE FEEL HONEST COMMUNICATION IS IMPORTANT. We want to respond, place facilities on a waiting list while exploring the possibility of neighboring areas fulfilling presentation, stay in contact with the facility & the area that the commitment falls in before we move forward with a presentation. -Delco is unable to facilitate the request at the George W prison due to lack of trusted servants & service efforts. Joe, H&I chair will reach out & communicate that we are working on the request & place the facility on a waiting list.

- Consistently eager Mr. Rodriguez has reached out to us 3 times about meetings at the new facility Lehigh Recovery. This falls in the ICA..we have tried numerous times to get ICA involved..but with no luck. We checked to see if Phila could cover the commitment..they have donated lit but can't take on the commitment. DANA has stepped up to the plate, scheduled & fulfilled the presentation which will be on Mondays going forward! This new facility Lehigh Recovery is part of the NET centers & is the replacement for the facility that closed down on 5<sup>th</sup> & spring garden. If addicts are in need of help this facility does do intake.
